Anna Ruzinski of the Menomonee Falls Police Department is the conference chair and is supported and assisted by chapter members from throughout the state. Wisconsin Chapter members hold a variety of senior and command positions representing hundreds of law enforcement agencies throughout Wisconsin.

The FBINAA National Conference will attract more than 1,800 National Academy delegates, criminal justice guests, family members and vendors. In addition, conference attendance includes state sponsored members of the National Academy's Youth Leadership Program that has graduated over 200 young delegates since the program's inception in 1999. A model program cultivating tomorrow's leaders, the Youth Leadership experience, which is hosted at the FBI Training Academy, is an opportunity for young adults to be formally exposed to a curriculum that fosters individual leadership, team involvement and personal development.

PURPOSE AND THEME

The primary purpose of the conference is to ensure that law enforcement leaders remain current on matters relating to their profession and to reinforce relationships and cooperation within policing and corporate communities at all levels.
